CAMPING RULES

Camping is allowed in the designated field, as a favour by the local Farmer. Any abuse of the use of this field will mean the facility to camp will not be available in future years. Remember the field is normally used to graze animals (four legged type, as opposed to the Two legged type attending the Festival), and the field must be left in a state that will not harm the animals. Therefore please follow the following.

- 1:- Take all your litter Home with you, or find a proper bin for it. NOT in the hedge.
- 2:- No Fires or BBQ. Fire risk and possible damage to surrounding tents
- 3:- Camping is only allowed in the top designated field, nowhere else - especially the car park.
- 4:- Respect Others. No Music, or parties after 23.30 at night. Sound carries, and some want to sleep. Want no rows about noise, from campers or adjoining houses.
- 5:- Please clear the Field by 2.00pm on Sunday 13 Sept.
- 6:- Drive slowly, max walking pace.
- 7:- The Museum, Camra, Beer Festival & Farmer take no responsibility for any damage, theft or loss in the field. Security is your problem not ours. Same for hurting yourself, If you hurt yourself it will be your fault.
- 8:- Toilets—please use the one on Plat 1 on the Station.
- 9:- If you are found to be in breach of these rules you will be immediately kicked off.
- 10:- If you do not agree with these rules, then find a Hotel.
